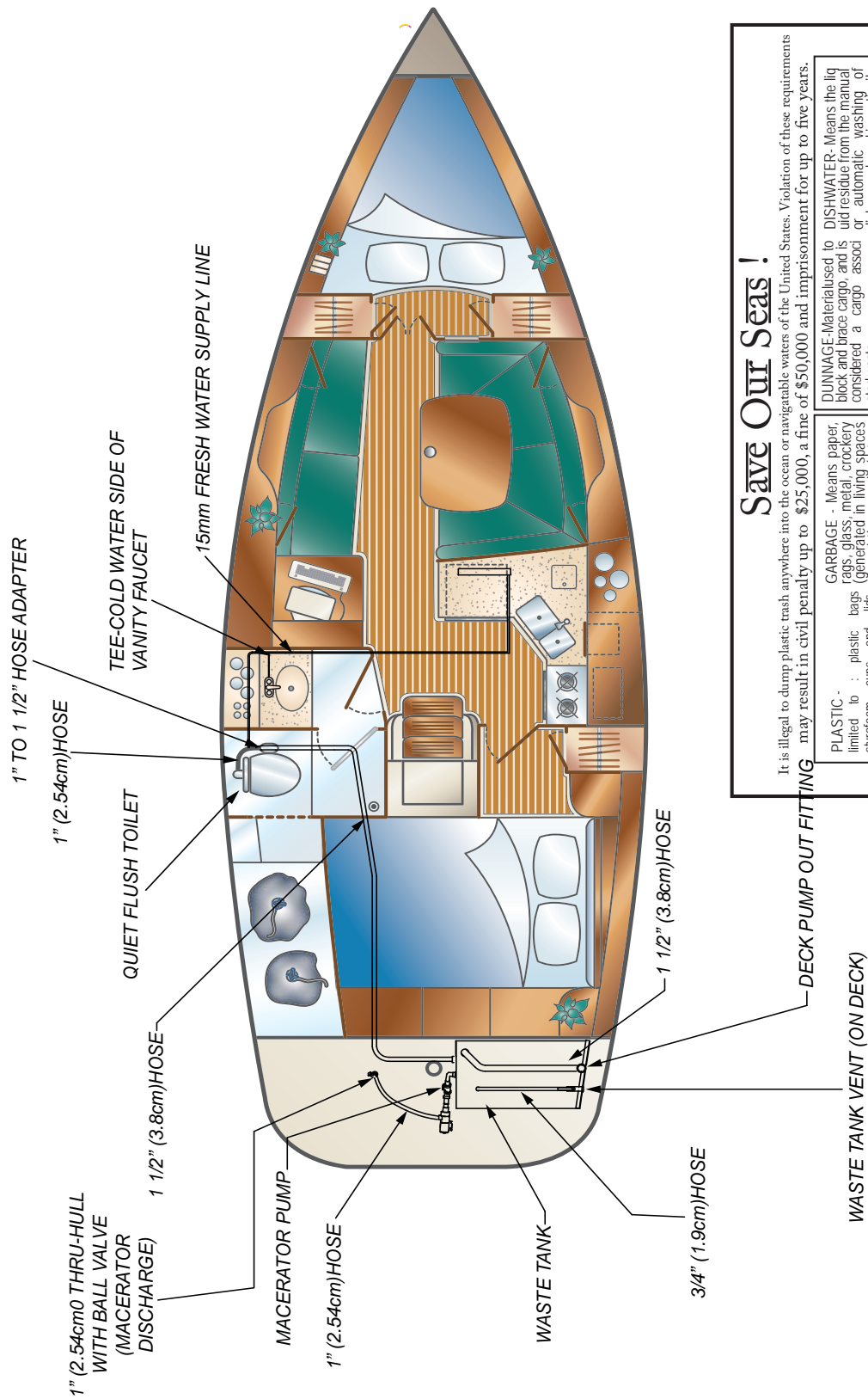


## Electric Toilet System (Black Water)



### Save Our Seas !

It is illegal to dump plastic trash anywhere into the ocean or navigable waters of the United States. Violation of these requirements may result in civil penalty up to \$25,000, a fine of \$50,000 and imprisonment for up to five years.

<b>PLASTIC</b> - limited to : plastic bags (generated in living spaces aboard the vessel-what we normally call trash), and all syrofoam cups and lids, sixpack holders, stirrers, synthetic fishing nets, ropes, lines, and bio or photo degradable plastics includes but is not fresh fish or fish parts, dishwater and gray water.	<b>DUNNAGE</b> -Material used to block and brace cargo and is considered a cargo associated waste.	<b>GRAYWATER</b> - Means drain age from a dishwasher, shower, laundry bath, and washbasin, and does not include drainage from toilets, urinals, hospitals, and cargo matic dishwashers.
