Mac, here it is. 3/8th cheap plywood and 1x3 s around the edges. Should have run the carpet down the back, had to add the cloth later after marking up the hull. I glassed the "arms" for strength. The cable is 1/8th I think and runs under the step as one continuous piece. I did not contour the "arms" to the hull curve, and they work fine. This set up only works if you have a slotted metal toe rail to hang the step from. Dimensions are about 28 inch wide and 23 deep. I will send you a pic with the arms folded for stowing.
