

## Mount Baker Rowing and Sailing Center Job Opening - Youth Sailing Coach



Mount Baker Rowing and Sailing Center has an exciting opportunity for a coach to join our growing Youth Sailing program. We are seeking applicants for the position of Youth Sailing Team Coach. This coach will plan and implement training and practice plans to prepare youth sailors for competition.

Practice schedule is as follows:

**February – Mid-March:** Saturday 10:00 am – 12:30 p.m.

**March – June:** Monday & Wednesday 3:30 – 6:30 p.m.

**July – September:** Tuesday & Thursday 5:30 – 8:00 p.m.

Weekend regattas will be scheduled in addition to this schedule which the coach will be expected to attend along with athletes. Additional hours may also be made available for boat/facility maintenance for qualified candidates.

### Qualifications:

- Passion for sailing and teaching youth.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills.
- Knowledge of Racing Rules of Sailing.
- At least 2 years dinghy sailing instruction. Youth coaching experience is highly preferred.
- High school or collegiate dinghy racing experience preferred.
- US Sailing Level 1 preferred.
- Experience organizing and officiating sailing regattas desired.
- Maintenance and repair of specialized sailing equipment desired.
- CPR & First Aid training is required within one month of hire.
- Washington Boaters Education certification prior to beginning of employment.
- Candidates must be able to pass a 10 minute float test prior to beginning of employment.

Compensation \$16-\$18/hour, commensurate with experience. This is a part-time, seasonal position.
